




#### NATTA DELEGATES MEET DG CAAN

October 31, A Seven-member delegation from Nepal Association of Tour & Travel Agents (NATTA) led by President Mr. D.B. Limbu called on the office of Mr. Ratish Chandra Lal Suman, Director General of Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal (CAAN) and apprised him of the current problems faced by tour operators at the Airport which they need to frequent in keeping with the prime

season of tourists in Nepal. The tour operators are barred from entering into the Golden Gate at the TIA. NATTA delegates have urged the DG to ease the mobility of the operators at TIA in the course of providing services at the arrival and departure. SAARC Summit should not deter the stakeholders from carrying out their duties. Tourists are equally important for the nation, the

delegates emphasized. Similarly, NAT-TA Delegates met Deputy Director of Civil Aviation Security, Mr. Bikram Raj Gautam to confirm on the same.

Secondly, President Mr. Limbu also xpressed NATTA's view in regard to the services of agents in collecting the Airport Development Fees. Therefore, NATTA should be included in the committee responsible to figure out the


plans and programs for physical development of the International Airports. NATTA delegates also hinted on the predicament of TIA and urged the management to go into action without much ado.

DG Mr. Suman said that works are underway to renovate the run way of the airport. The departure belt will be relocated with increase in number to four. The Check-in counter will also

see the facelift with increased capacity. The whole baggage handling system too will be automised. The complete airport will have aircondition with granite floor and escalators will be installed. All the above plans will be fully materialized by the end of 2015, DG Mr. Suman assured the delegates. For parking a multi-storied complex is in the plan and the ground floor is already complete, he said.
