This has been celebrated as an auspicious occasion. People go to field, play with the mud and water, plant rice and eat the beaten rice with yoghurt (Dahi Chiura). Traditional songs are sung. Over the years tourists visiting such sites join the merriment of the day, joining the local tradition with great interest and tend to enjoy to the fullest.
