Everest Region

Mount Everest, also known in Nepal as Sagarmatha and in Tibet as Chomolungma, is Earth's highest mountain. It is located in the Mahalangur mountain range in Nepal and Tibet. Its peak is 8,848 metres (29,029 ft) above sea level. Its massif includes neighbouring peaks Lhotse, 8,516 m (27,940 ft); Nuptse, 7,855 m (25,771 ft) and Changtse, 7,580 m (24,870 ft).

Mount Everest attracts many climbers, some of them highly experienced mountaineers. The first recorded efforts to reach Everest's summit were made by British mountaineers. Tenzing Norgay and Edmund Hillary made the first successful official ascent of Everest in 1953 using the southeast ridge route.
